

# FUNCTIONAL MOVEMENT DISORDER

**Course Description:** This 1.25 hour CEU course will introduce and teach physical therapists and related professionals about functional movement disorder. This will include defining FMD, factors that may predispose a person to develop FMD, symptoms and signs of the disorder, how it is diagnosed and what fMRI tells us about persons with FMD. Learners will then dive into treatment strategies, focusing primarily on how physiotherapists can work to eliminate systems in persons with FMD and concludes with a case study presentation. Evidence and multiple research studies are discussed, providing learners the most up to date information about a diagnosis that they may not know much about. 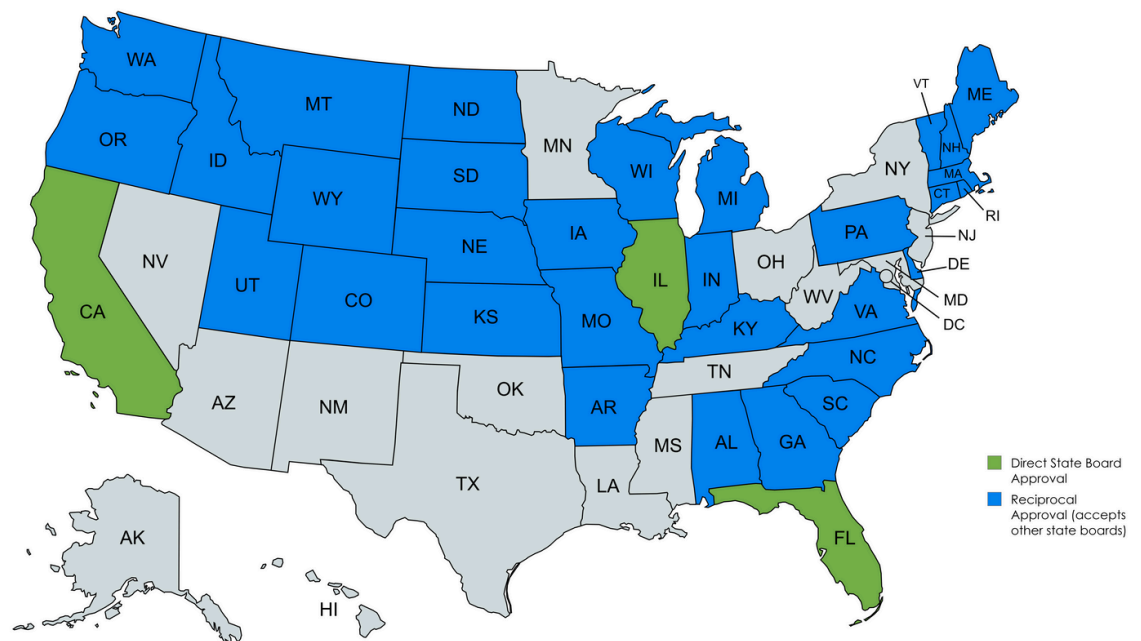
