

BENEFITS OF A PERSONAL EXOSKELETON

Course Description: This 0.75 hour CEU course will introduce physical therapists and related professionals to personal exoskeletons for persons with spinal cord injury. The student will learn the benefits of these devices and why their patient may benefit. This course is hosted online and is not live.


