## 1. Purpose and Scope

The Australasian College of Oral Health Practitioners (ACOHP) is committed to safeguarding the privacy and security of your personal information. This Privacy Policy outlines our practices concerning the collection, use, disclosure, and protection of your personal data. By accessing our services and providing your information, you consent to the practices described in this policy.

#### 2. Information We Collect:
