Description

This 16-hour live continuing education program provides licensed mental health professionals with intermediate-level competencies in psychedelic-informed care. The curriculum integrates trauma-informed psychotherapy, somatic approaches, cultural humility, polyvagal foundations, ethical decision-making, and evidence-based frameworks for preparation and integration work.

Target Audience/Level

This program is designed for licensed clinical social workers, professional counselors, marriage and family therapists, psychologists, psychiatric nurse practitioners, and other licensed behavioral health professionals who intend to incorporate psychedelic-informed care into their clinical practice. This course is at an **Intermediate level** and is designed for clinicians with existing experience in therapeutic practice.

- Apply trauma-informed frameworks and somatic interventions to psychedelic integration sessions.
- Differentiate dissociation, ego dissolution, spiritual emergence, and psychiatric crises.
- Analyze ethical issues related to scope of practice, informed consent, and power dynamics.
- Utilize evidence-based models and tools to facilitate meaning-making and integration.
- Evaluate cultural humility considerations within psychedelic-informed care.
- Implement individual and group integration methodologies within clinical boundaries.
