Lesson**Create New Life**

You already know that the main reason God invented sex was for husbands and wives to be able to have babies and children. But there are more reasons for why God created sex to work the way it does.

Bonding

The word “bonding” means sticking two things together so that they cannot be separated again. You have already learned that God says when a man and woman have sex it makes them “become one” which is the same thing as bonding.

God designed humans in a way that when a person has sex, something happens in their brain that makes them feel bonded to whoever they are having sex with. It causes a husband and wife to want to stay together.

For Husbands and Wives Only

Sex was designed to be only for husbands and wives. Sex bonds people together in a very powerful way, which is good. That is what God wants for a husband and wife. But it is not good to become bonded like this to anyone else. A bond as strong as this is only meant to be shared by a husband and wife.

Sex is Good

God invented sex. Sex was God's idea. Sex is designed for a husband and wife to enjoy together. Sex was designed to be a special thing a husband or wife shares with no one else but their spouse.
