Transracial Adoption

- How to prepare your kids in advance for changes to the family routine to accommodate the new child's needs.
- Creating a support network in advance.
- Handling the transition period.
- Different expectations and rules.
- How much voice should children in the family have on whether to adopt?
- Advice on parenting if you are disrupting birth order.
- Advice on parenting if kids are in the same grade at school.

Adopting an Older Child Who is Your Foster Child

- Role change from foster sibling to adoptive sibling (and foster parent to adoptive parent).
- Expectations of transition period.
