## **Art Supplies**

In this list I try to provide options for the various tools. Also, it isn't necessary to use the same brands that I do, as long as you are using student grade materials or better.

- Two Sheets of Hot Press, 140lb, Watercolor Paper, aprox. 11" x 17" or larger.
   I am using 11.69" x 16.53" Arches Hot Press Water Color Pad
   Or you can buy one large individual sheet and then cut it into several sheets.
- One 12" x 16" Gessoed Surface that is sturdy.
   It could be a <u>stretched canvas</u>, 300lb watercolor paper, or a <u>hard wood panel</u>.
- 3. **Several 8.5"x11" sheets of your favorite drawing paper**. Your paper shouldn't be any thicker than scrapbook paper aprox. 24lb to 60lb.
- 4. **A board** to tape your watercolor paper to and some Masking or Painters Tape.
- 5. **Graphite Pencils** assorted soft and hard.
- 6. **Vine Charcoal or Very Soft Graphite Pencil or Dk. Grey Pastel** (Choose One)
- 7. **Erasers:** White Plastic Eraser & a Kneadable Eraser.
- 8. **Blending Stumps** or Q-tips
- 9. Dry Pastels: A Basic Set of pan pastels or stick chalk pastels (artist grade). I use my old stick pastels in the lessons, as they are so versatile. However, I recommend pan pastels for the lesson, if you can afford them. Recommended Colors are:

Dark Blue
 Medium Blue
 Light Blue
 a Pink or Magenta Tint
 Yellow
 White

o a Violet or Purple o Black

10. **AcrylicPaints:** A basic set of artist grade acrylics.

Recommended Colors are:

o Red, Blue

o Yellow

Purple

o Orange, Green

o White, Black

o Burnt Sienna

Yellow Ochre or Naples Yellow

- 11. Acrylic Matte Varnish
- 12. Matte Fixative
- 13. A Basic Set of Acrylic Paint Brushes
- 14. **A Fan Brush** (optional, but highly recommended)
- 15.1"to 2" Foam Brush or Golden Talon Brush (for brushing on acrylic varnish)
- 16. **Decorative Collage Papers**

- 17. **Craft Knife or Small Scissors** for cutting collage elements
- 18. **Cutting Matt** or a Piece of Cardboard
- 19. A Compass for Drawing Circles or a round plate you can trace (optional).
- 20. Texture Cards for Mixed Media

or you can use a sheet of cardboard or an old credit card to make your own.

- 21. A Nail File, plastic knife, palette knife, or something comparable for shaving stick pastels safely. If you have pan pastels don't worry about it.
- 22. **Palette** for your paint
- 23. Water & Paper Towels

## **Optional Supplies:**

- 1. Various <u>Templates</u> or Paper Doilies
- 2. Decorative <u>Foam Stamps</u> or your own rubber stamps
- 3. Round Foam Sponges for creating textures
- 4. Clickable Eraser for fine details
- 5. Gold Metallic Acrylic Paint
- 6. White Gel Pen
- 7. A Brayer or an Old Credit Card or something you can use to safely press down your collage.
