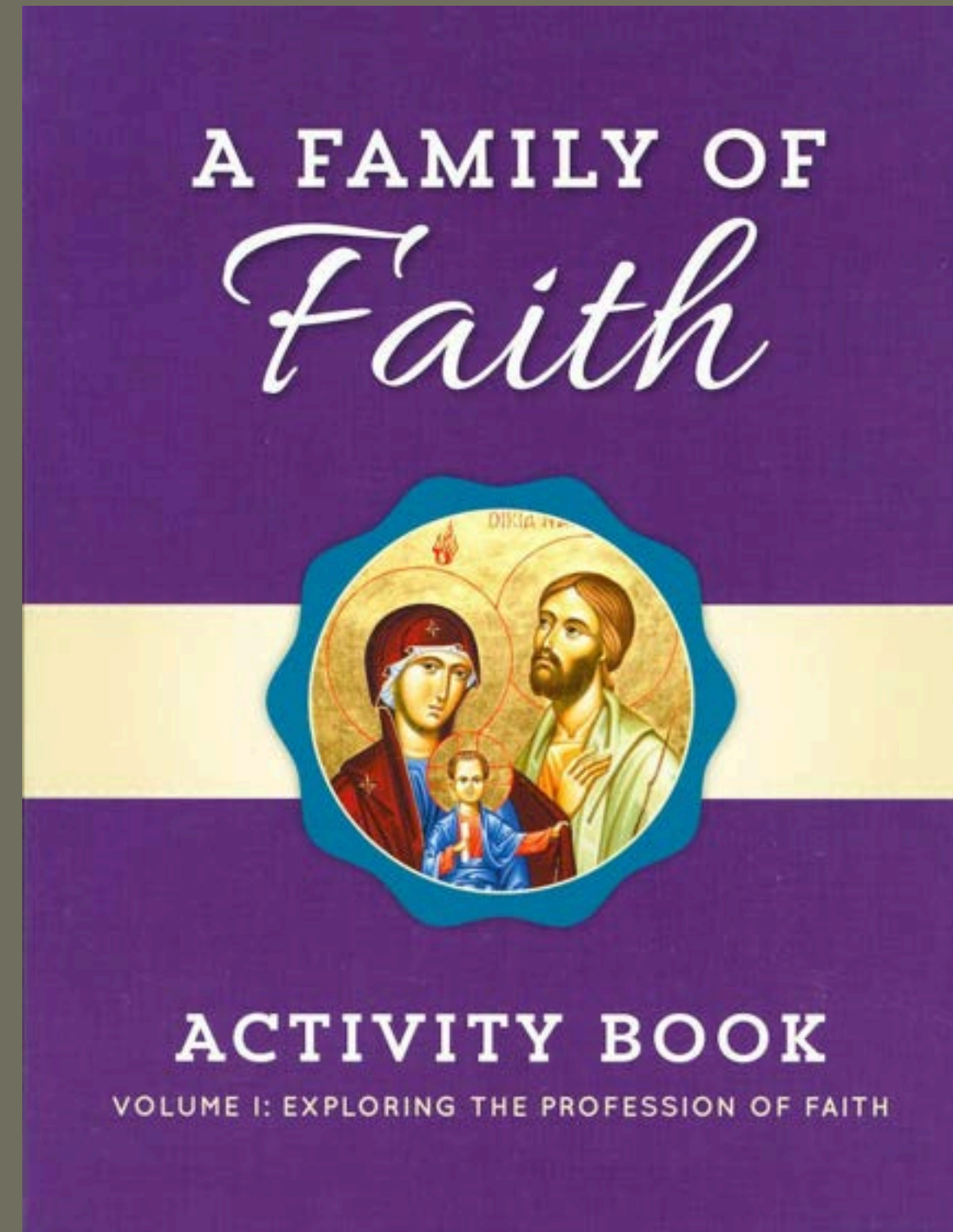
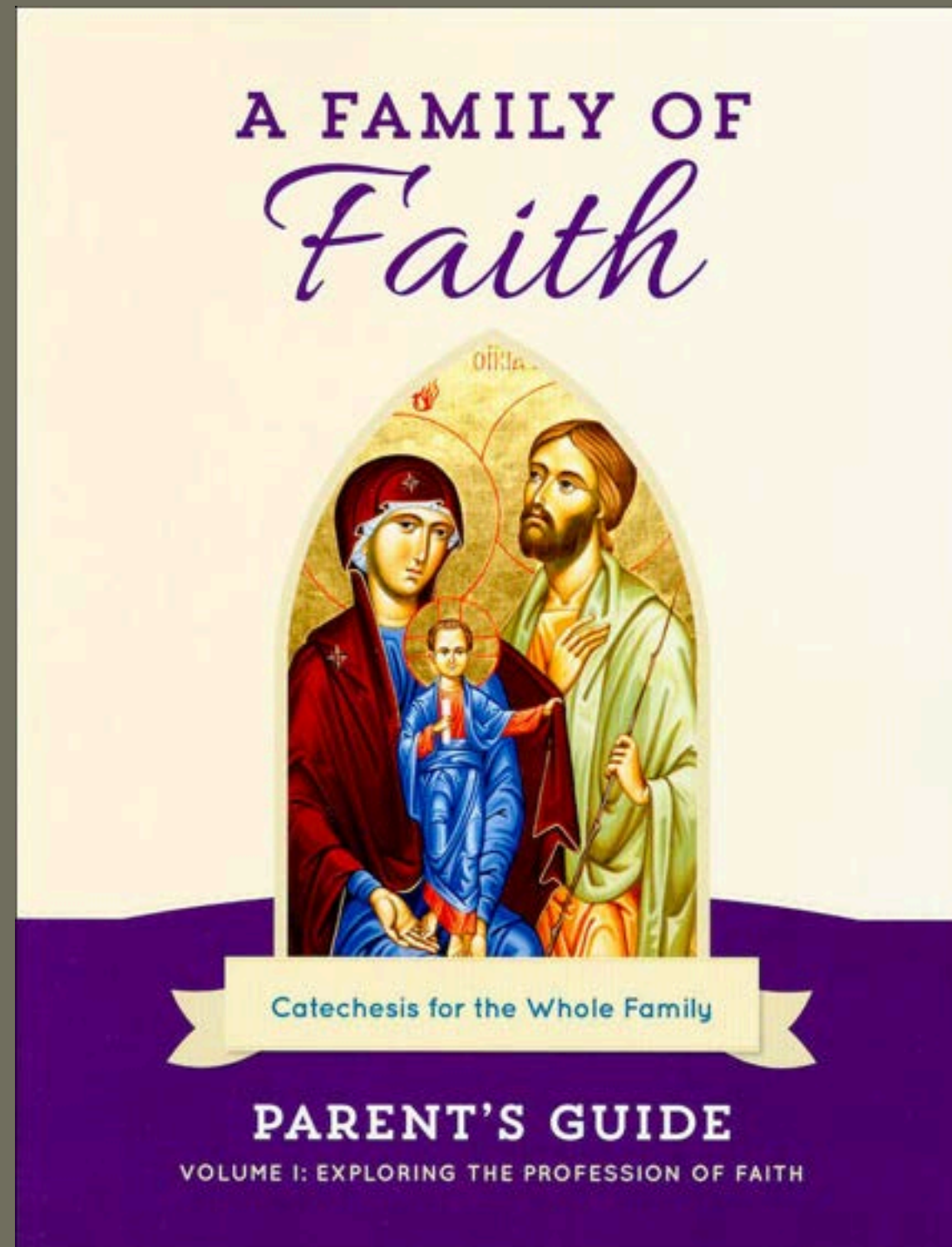

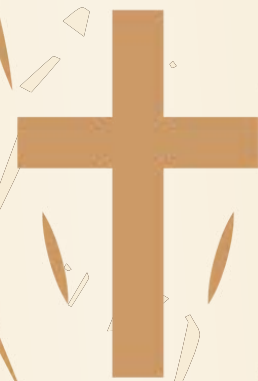

ONE

Ephesians 4:4-6



- One origin: one God, one Body of Christ, unified by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit
- Unity in faith: the full Deposit of Faith, taught since the time of the apostles
- Unity in governance: the apostolic succession, governed by the bond of unity of the office of Peter
- Unity in worship: the Mass, the Eucharist, the other sacraments
- Diversity in cultures, offices, ministries, vocations, and liturgical expressions do not alter unity
- Sins of heresy, apostasy, and schism have throughout history wounded the Church's unity

ONE

Christ intended that we be ONE church



John 17:11, 21

"Holy Father, protect them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one, as we are one"



Ephesians 4:5

"one Lord, one faith, one baptism"



Action

Pray for unity among Christians and unity with one another.



HOLY

John 17:15-19



- Holiness in her founder: Jesus, holy as God alone is holy, who sanctified the church with the Holy Spirit
- Holiness in her call: Jesus calls all to the perfection of the Father
- Holiness in her ability to sanctify her members: all grace merited by Jesus and all the means of salvation are given to us by the Church, most especially Jesus himself in the Eucharist
- Holiness in her saints, especially the Blessed Virgin Mary: the models of what God can accomplish, the holy human sources of the Church's activity and zeal, the intercessors before us to God
- Although the Church herself is holy, her members are sinners and so her holiness is not perfect yet

- As the Father sent Jesus, so he chose the apostles and sent them with His own authority
- The apostles' authority is handed down through their successors, the Pope and the bishops
- Kept without error by the Holy Spirit, Jesus' teaching is handed down intact through apostolic succession
- Apostolic succession is the guarantee of our access to the fullness of truth and the saving graces of Christ

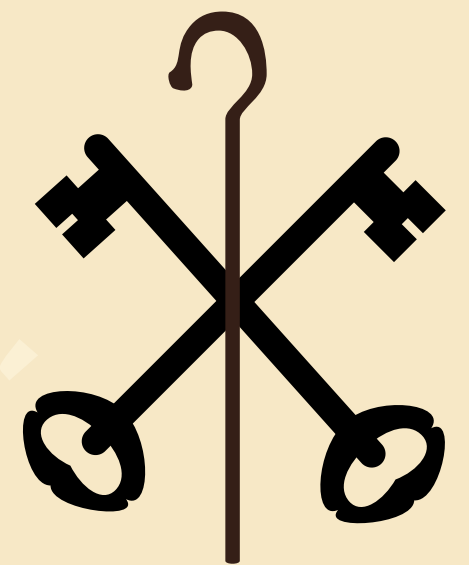
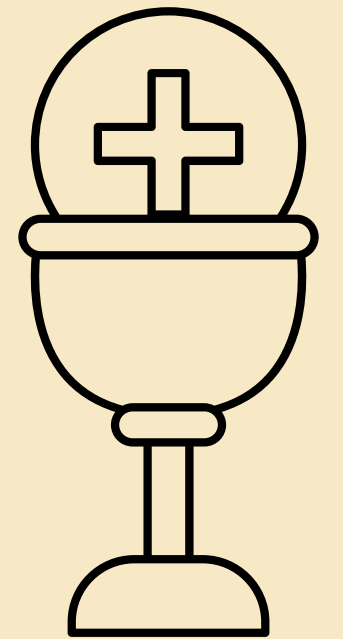

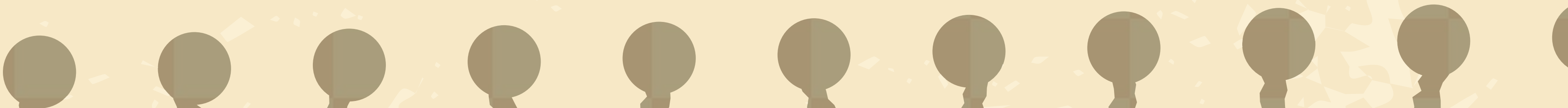

CCC 866

The Church is one: she acknowledges one Lord, confesses one faith, is born of one Baptism, forms only one Body, is given life by the one Spirit, for the sake of one hope, at whose fulfillment all divisions will be overcome.



CCC 867

The Church is holy: the Most Holy God is her author; Christ, her bridegroom, gave himself up to make her holy; the Spirit of holiness gives her life. Since she still includes sinners, she is "the sinless one made up of sinners." Her holiness shines in the saints; in Mary she is already all-holy.



ccc 868

The Church is catholic: she proclaims the fullness of the faith. She bears in herself and administers the totality of the means of salvation. She is sent out to all peoples. She speaks to all men. She encompasses all times. She is "missionary of her very nature".



CCC 869

The Church is apostolic. She is built on a lasting foundation: "the twelve apostles of the Lamb". She is indestructible. She is upheld infallibly in the truth: Christ governs her through Peter and the other apostles, who are present in their successors, the Pope and the college of bishops.
