KEY *points*

- Jesus told the Apostles to heal the sick in His name.
- Our suffering can be redemptive if we unite it to Christ's.
- The Triduum begins with evening Mass on Holy Thursday and ends with Evening Prayer on Easter Sunday.
- The Easter Vigil is the greatest celebration in the Church year.
- CCC 1499 - By the sacred anointing of the sick and the prayer of the priests the whole Church commends those who are ill to the suffering and glorified Lord, that he may raise them up and save them.
