

Quality Papers

A three-hour course that enables participants to:

- identify that journal's requirements and paper structures,
- write a message that sums up their findings / ideas,
- use this message and the journals structure to decide what needs to be included.

Pre-Course Information

This is a practical 'hands-on' workshop. To make the most of the session you will need to bring the following:

- 1) An idea of a paper you would like to write
- 2) two to four papers that have been published RECENTLY in your TARGET JOURNAL (the one you want your paper in). Where possible select papers that also cover similar research to your own in terms of methodological approach and subject area. Ideally these papers will be in paper format. It is a good idea to pick papers that you thought were well written because during the day you will examine them to guide your writing.
