Y-LED is being expanded in FY24 to give youth opportunities to co-design digital learning for their peers, advocate for inclusive sex ed, complete trainings to deliver sex ed and wellness programs in their communities, and more!

## **Young Parents**

The Teen Parent Support Program (TPSP) is a comprehensive case management program in Santa Clara County offering:

- Strength-based coaching, resource navigation
- Support obtaining high school diploma or to pursue post-secondary pathways

#### **Mental Health First Aid**

PPMM's certified instructors lead trainings for teens who learn this evidence-based model (tMHFA) for recognizing early signs of mental health challenges in their peers, and how to refer youth to local services and connect with trusted adults for more support.

#### **Sex Ed Equity Project**

PPMM partners are delivering evidence-based sex ed and creating a web of support for youth in Tulare, Kern, and Washoe counties (funded by the Office of Population Affairs: Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program). Programs include: Plan A, Power Through Choices, LiFT (Linking Families & Teens), Cuidate, and Positive Prevention Plus.
