Should we start getting ready for Jesus at the end of our lives or right now?




How can we live our lives like followers of Jesus every day?




How can we create a home that is welcoming for Jesus? How can we create a heart that's always ready to receive him?

**Belt of truth** 


**Breastplate of righteousness**
