What do you need for making the Prince



- .Sculpting tool
- .Sculpting brush
- .Kitchen knife.

Creative paperclay (<u>www.paperclay.com</u>)
(Michaels sells it sometimes too)



.Masking tape



- .Styrofoam egg from 2.5 inches up to 3 inches
- .Two short pieces of a skewer to use on the arms
- .One skewer to push in the egg
- . Two pieces of strong but bendable wire for the legs 2×7 inches
- . Two pieces of strong bendable wire for the arms 2×9 inches
- I like to use electrical wire, but every firm but bendable wire will be okay
- .For sculpting I also like to use a synthetic brush with a flat point



- .A Styrofoam roll about 1.5 inches wide and 8 inches long Hobby Lobby sells these rolls
- .Two rolls of stretched gauze (Pharmacy)
- .Something that you can push into the clay to make an imprint, like a metal ornament or a piece of firm lace



.A little Styrofoam ball, cut in half 1.5 inch



.Bowl to hold water



.Fine sanding sponges (Hardware store)
.Clay roller





.Two foam rolls:

I buy these foam rolls in a hair shop, pharmacy or dollar store.

It is old fashion material to make curlers in your hair. I take the wire out and put my own electrical wire in, because the wire needs to be longer to put on one side in

the hand base form and on the other side to push into the body. The length for the arm is about 6 inches.

When you cannot find these than you can use for each arm a small roll of stretched gauze

.One roll of stretched gauze



.Varnish for water colour paint

I use MAT varnish from Talens for watercolour paint They also sell this varnish at JoAnn's on-line and you have to go to Van Gogh products

- .Brush to varnish
- .Solvent to clean the brush
- .Soft piece of cotton like an old handkerchief
- .Awl



.Make-up sponges .Pinkish make-up powder



.Eye make-up powder in different colours



Paint: Water colour paints
Lemon Yellow
Sepia
Ultramarin Blue
Red
White
Ivory Black

.White tile or plate for painting. No plastic plate .Fine painting brush. I use a synthetic brush nr. 001







.Acrylic paint for the shoes and the bodice after your own choice that matches the costume



- .Needles and pins
- .Thread
- .Pair of sharp scissors



.Piece of unbleached cotton for the legs. See patterns



.Bit of stuffing for the legs

.Fabrics for the costume after your own choice for:

- .the trousers and cuffs
- .the waist
- .the sleeves
- .the collar
- .Lace for crown
- .Hair
- .Materials for embellishments

.Fast Grab Tacky glue







Materials to make a base form for the Prince to sit on, like

- .A Styrofoam roll that will be covered with fabric
- .Bottom form like a wooden plate

.Smaller wooden plate to put on the top



- .Ironing table and ironing machine
- .Sewing machine
