

National Integrity Before National Security

Executive Summary

A Case for the American People

Introduction

This Executive Summary presents the core findings and thesis of the American Common Law case titled “**National Integrity Before National Security.**” This case asserts that the integrity of the fifty American States of the Union—which are nations themselves under common law—and their constitutional union as a nation, must be preserved as **essential and necessary** before any claim of “national security” can be legitimately invoked.

The American system of government was founded upon the Laws of Nature and Nature’s God, as articulated in the Declaration of Independence. These principles established that sovereignty resides in the People, that rights come from the Creator and are unalienable, and that governments are instituted among men to secure these rights—not to abrogate them under pretense of protection.

This case demonstrates that “national security” has become a rhetorical device employed to subvert the very republic it purports to protect.

Core Thesis

National Integrity Must Precede National Security

The fundamental proposition of this case is simple yet profound:

There can be no legitimate “national security” without first preserving “national integrity.”

National Integrity encompasses:

- The preservation of the constitutional republican form of government guaranteed to each state
- The maintenance of the People’s sovereign authority over their government servants
- The protection of unalienable rights as the primary purpose of government
- The proper functioning of Common Law Courts and jury trials
- The constitutional monetary system established by the People
- The balance of power between federal and state governments
- The right of self-governance under natural law principles

National Security, as improperly invoked, has become:

- A justification for executive overreach and unconstitutional legislation
- A pretext for surveillance and violation of privacy rights
- An excuse for denial of due process and jury trial
- A mechanism for concentrating power contrary to constitutional design
- A shield protecting government actors from accountability

When “national security” is used to undermine national integrity, it destroys the very nation it claims to protect. A nation that sacrifices its founding principles for security will have neither.

Key Findings

Finding 1: The Constitutional Foundation Has Been Subverted

The Declaration of Independence established that:

- All men are created equal
- All men are endowed by their Creator with unalienable rights
- Governments derive their just powers from the consent of the governed
- The People have the right to alter or abolish destructive government

These principles, codified in our constitutional system, have been systematically undermined under color of “national security” through:

1. **The Organic Act of 1871** — which reconstituted the United States as a corporate entity
2. **The Federal Reserve Act of 1913** — which transferred monetary control to foreign bankers
3. **The Trading with the Enemy Act amendments** — which declared war against the American People
4. **The Patriot Act** — which authorized mass surveillance without probable cause
5. **The National Defense Authorization Act** — which authorized indefinite detention without due process
6. **Executive Orders** — which have assumed legislative powers never granted by the People

Finding 2: Common Law Courts Have Been Replaced by Statutory Tribunals

The People’s heritage of Common Law courts proceeding according to natural law has been concealed and replaced with chancery (equity) courts that:

- Deny fully informed juries the right to judge both facts AND law
- Stack and taint grand juries through government-controlled questionnaires
- Transform unalienable rights into statutory privileges
- Impose excessive fines, fees, and punishments
- Deny access to courts of record where jury decisions are final

As the Supreme Court affirmed in *United States v. Williams* (1992):

“The grand jury is an institution separate from the courts, over whose functioning the courts do not preside... it belongs to no branch of the institutional government, serving as a kind of buffer or referee between the Government and the people.”

This buffer has been corrupted, leaving the People without their primary protection against government tyranny.

Finding 3: “National Security” Has Become the Enemy of Liberty

Every tyranny in history has justified its oppressions by claiming necessity for security. The American founders understood this danger:

“Necessity is the plea for every infringement of human freedom. It is the argument of tyrants; it is the creed of slaves.” — William Pitt

Under the guise of “national security,” government actors have:

- Suspended habeas corpus
- Detained citizens without charges or trial
- Conducted warrantless surveillance on millions of Americans
- Created secret courts and classified proceedings
- Denied the People access to evidence used against them
- Claimed immunity from accountability for constitutional violations
- Prosecuted whistleblowers who expose government wrongdoing
- Used intelligence agencies against domestic political opponents

Finding 4: The Balance of Power Has Been Destroyed

The constitutional design established:

- **Horizontal separation:** Three branches—Legislative, Executive, Judicial
- **Vertical separation:** Federal and State governments
- **Popular check:** Grand Jury and Trial Jury as tribunals of the People
- **Written consent:** Constitution limiting government to enumerated powers

This balance has been destroyed through:

- Executive legislation via orders, directives, and regulations
- Judicial legislation from the bench
- Administrative agencies exercising quasi-legislative and quasi-judicial powers
- Federal usurpation of state authority
- Corruption of jury processes
- Concentration of power in unaccountable bureaucracies

Finding 5: Natural Rights Have Been Transformed Into Crimes

The Bill of Rights—more accurately termed the “Bill of Prohibitions” against government—has been systematically violated:

- **First Amendment:** Speech criminalized, religion restricted, petition rights ignored
- **Second Amendment:** Arms rights licensed, regulated, and infringed
- **Fourth Amendment:** Mass surveillance, warrantless searches, violation of privacy
- **Fifth Amendment:** Grand jury processes corrupted, due process denied
- **Sixth Amendment:** Jury trials denied, assistance of counsel corrupted by BAR monopoly
- **Seventh Amendment:** Common law suits denied, jury powers limited
- **Eighth Amendment:** Excessive fines, civil asset forfeiture, cruel punishments
- **Ninth and Tenth Amendments:** Reserved rights ignored, states coerced

Summary of Constitutional Violations

The evidence demonstrates systematic violation of the constitutional compact through invocation of “national security,” including:

- Free access to courts for natural persons

2. Nullification of Unconstitutional Acts

- The Patriot Act
- NDAA detention provisions
- Federal Reserve Act
- Rules Enabling Act of 1934 and FRCP
- Executive orders claiming legislative power

3. Accountability for Government Actors

- Removal of unconstitutional immunity doctrines
- Prosecution of officials who violate constitutional rights under color of “national security”
- Restoration of Writ Quo Warranto to challenge unlawful authority

4. Restoration of Constitutional Structure

- Re-establishment of proper separation of powers

- Restoration of state sovereignty under 10th Amendment
- Return to constitutional monetary system
- Abolition of administrative agencies exercising unconstitutional powers

5. Protection of Natural Rights

- Recognition that rights come from Creator, not government
- Restoration of all rights secured by the Bill of Prohibitions
- End of licensing and regulation of unalienable rights

Conclusion

The American experiment in self-governance established that the People are sovereign and their government exists only to secure their unalienable rights. This experiment cannot survive if “national security” becomes the justification for destroying everything the nation was created to protect.

National integrity is not opposed to national security—it IS national security.
