

NAVIGATING YOUR ONLINE LEARNING PLATFORM

1. Launch the online class portal via https://learn.yangchenma.org/ Enter your login information using the email address used at registration. If you plan to register for multiple courses be sure to use the same email address for all to ensure that each class you are enrolled in appears on your Dashboard.

Mobile View:






If you are having trouble logging in in or forgot your password, you can reset it at any time by clicking on the "Forgot Your Password?" Link:




2. Once logged in, click on the gray avatar in upper right corner to update your account profile (you can also do this later):



Here you can update your billing information or change your password. International students can also select their language:




3. Click on "My Dashboard" to view your courses and communities:



4. Enter your course by clicking on its icon image


Here is a view of what a typical course looks like for a logged in student:



Select any of the sections on the left side to view the course content. You will find your Zoom links for live courses, videos, additional resources such as PDF files, audio files and all other course content.


For certain courses that have pre-requisite content, you will have to click "Complete & Continue" at the end of each section to be able to advance onto the next.

Please note that if you are using a mobile to view the class, you will need to open up the navigation on the left by clicking the three horizontal lines on the top left of your screen. After that you will be able to view the navigation bar and select the course sections to view:



You may navigate back to your main student dashbaord at any time from the top left of your screen.

5. From your student dashboard you can also access your "Communities":



When you enroll in a course, you will automatically have access to a private community forum. Much like a Facebook private group, this is a place where you can discuss and share resources with your teacher and classmates related to the course content or upload your work for them to view. Participation in these communities is totally optional. We ask only that you keep the conversation related to course content and maintain an atmosphere of kindness and respect for all.
