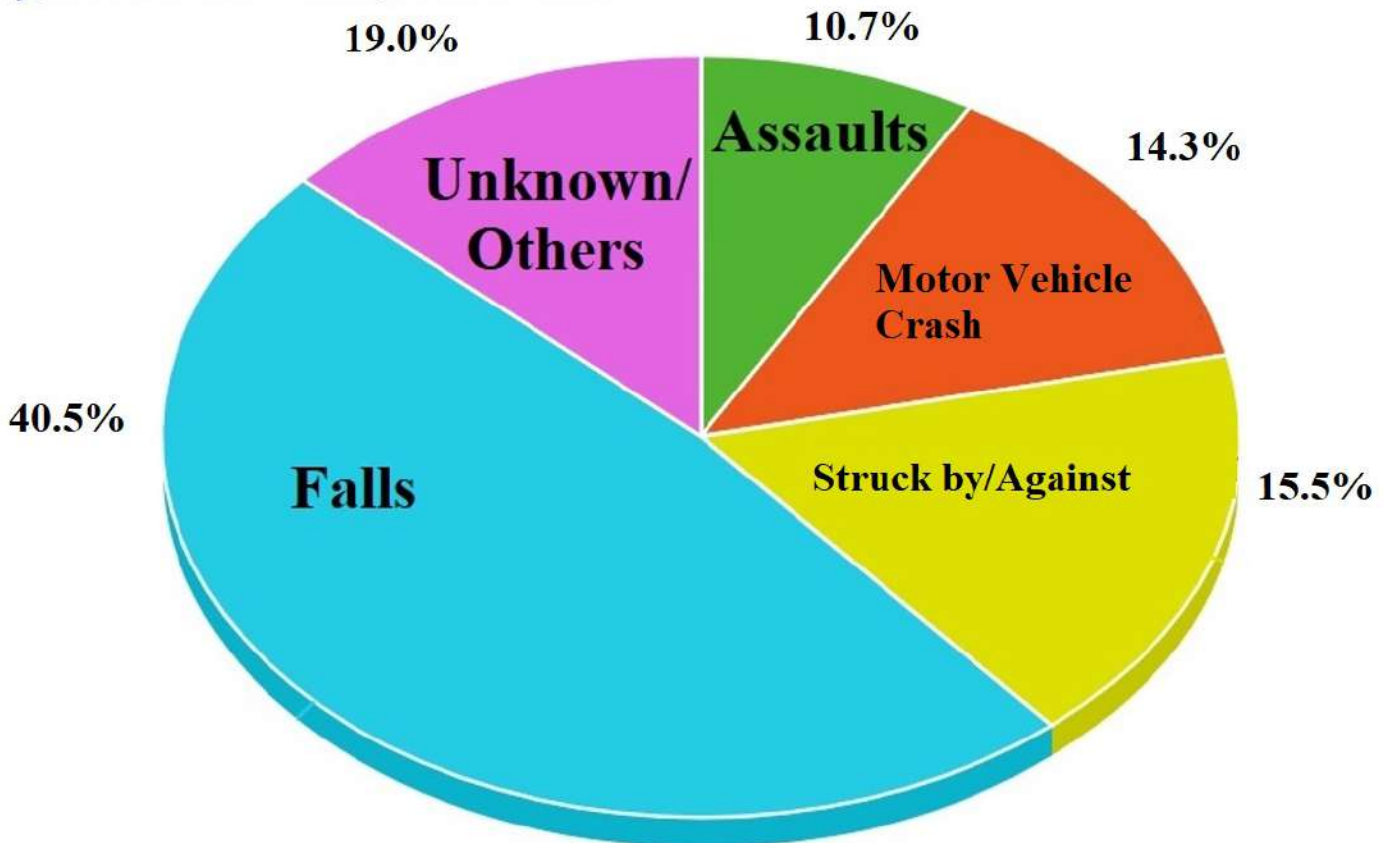


Common Causes of Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)

Non-Traumatic Brain Injury Causes

A non-traumatic brain injury may also be called an acquired brain injury or ABI. This type of brain injury is the result of an illness or condition within the body, and it is not a result of a blow to the head (Shepherd Center, 2020).

- Stroke (leading cause)
- Lack of oxygen (hypoxia)
- Tumors
- Other illness such as cancer
- Brain infections or inflammation
- Other infections
