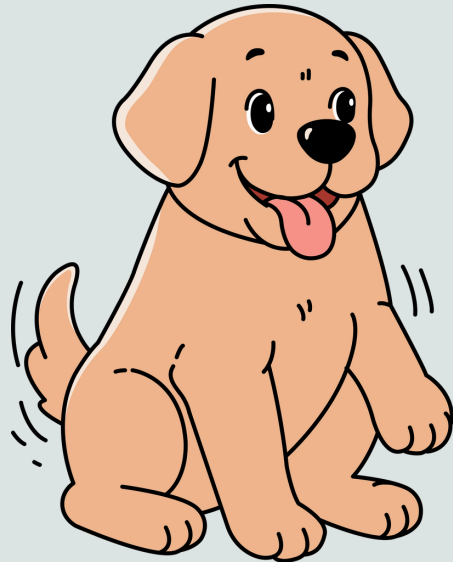


Pet Body Language

Happy

- Tail wagging (broad, slow)
- Panting with relaxed body



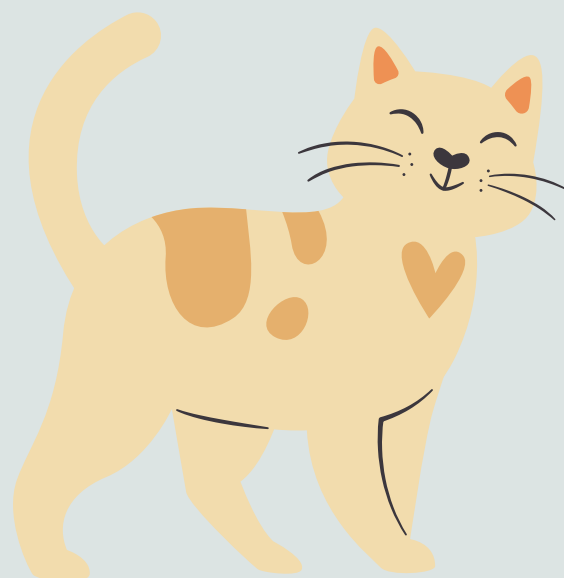
Fearful

- Tail tucked
- Ears pinned back
- Panting



Uncomfortable

- Growling or baring teeth
- Hackles may be raised;
- Tension visible throughout body



Happy

- Tail up, quivering
- Purring
- Slow Blinking



Annoyed

- Tail flicking or lashing
- Ears flat or sideways



Fearful

- Arched back, puffed fur
- Ears flat or sideways
