This guide will help you get your business phone registered across major carriers and spam protection services to increase your call answer rates and avoid being flagged as spam.

Step 1: Prepare Your Business Information

Before you start registering with each service, gather the following information:

- Business name
- Business phone number(s) you wish to register
- Contact person
- Business address
- Business email
- Any additional business identification or credentials that may be required



Step 2: Register with the Free Caller Registry

The Free Caller Registry is a central database where you can register your business phone numbers. Start with this registry, as it serves multiple carriers and spam protection services.

- Visit [Free Caller Registry](#)
- Click on “Sign Up”
- Follow the prompts to create an account
- Complete the registration form with your business information
- Submit the form and wait for confirmation of your registration

Step 3: Register with Major Carriers

Next, register your business phone numbers with the major carriers' spam protection services to ensure your calls are not flagged as spam.

1. AT&T Registry

- Visit [AT&T Registry](#)
- Complete the form with your business information
- Submit your request to get your number registered

2. T-Mobile Direct Registry

- Visit [T-Mobile Direct Registry](#)
- Sign up or log in if you already have an account
- Follow the prompts to register your business phone number

3. Verizon Direct Registry

- Visit [Verizon Direct Registry](#)
- Complete the form with your business information and submit it



Step 4: Register with Other Spam Protection Services

To further ensure your number isn't flagged as spam, register with these additional spam protection services.



1. First Orion Registry

- Visit [First Orion Registry](#)
- Sign up or log in to your existing account
- Follow the prompts to register your business phone number

2. TNS Registry

- Visit [TNS Registry](#)
- Complete the form and submit your business information

3. Xfinity Registry

- Visit [Xfinity Registry](#).
- Complete the form to submit your business information

By following these steps and registering with the websites provided, you will reduce the chances of your business phone number being flagged as spam.
